## 12. GENERAL BUSINESS

### 12.1 Hansard Street, Zetland

#### **Proposed Partial closure at Botany Road Zetland Area Traffic Study**

#### **Background:**

Over past years, residents in Hansard Street have raised concerns that Hansard Street is being used by motorists as a rat-run to avoid the congestion at the Botany and Epsom Roads intersection. Southbound drivers in Botany Road often turn left into Hansard Street to reach Epsom Road, via Dunning Avenue and northbound drivers also use the same route to reach Epsom Road by not waiting for the right turn signal. This is due to the traffic delays at Botany Road and Epsom Road.

#### **Comments:**

A report of the Zetland Area Traffic Study was submitted to the City's Planning Development and Transport Committee on 4 April 2005 and to the Council on 11 April 2005 for endorsement. The Council resolved that:

- (A) The subject report be received and noted;
- (B) Commencement of recommended local area traffic management works in the Zetland area as outline in this report, with the highest priority item being partial closure (left out only) from Hansard Street at Botany Road.

The Zetland Area Traffic Study recommended that Hansard Street be made left out only at its intersection with Botany Road to eliminate the rat-run through Hansard Street, via Dunning Avenue to Epsom Road (See Attachment 12.1).

Accordingly, the following recommendation is made.

#### **Recommendation:**

That the Committee agrees in principle for the City to take advertising action under Section 116 of the Roads Act 1993, to make Hansard Street, Zetland left out only at Botany Road by a partial closure of Hansard Street at Botany Road.

#### **Decision:**

The Committee adopted the Recommendation subject to cycle access being maintained through the partial closure.
