ITEM 8.1

ITEM 8.2

REVIEW OF THE GRANTS AND SPONSORSHIP POLICY (S031204)

It is resolved that:

- (A) the amended Grants and Sponsorship Policy, shown at Attachment A to the subject report, be adopted;
- (B) value-in-kind is to be determined as only that which is revenue foregone to the City:
 - (1) park hire;
 - (2) venue hire, including reduced rates (community and major venues);
 - (3) banner pole hire; and
 - (4) community bus hire.
- (C) Council note that the Environmental Grants Program, the Heritage Grants Program and the History Publication Sponsorship Program have been incorporated into the Grants and Sponsorship Policy, shown at Attachment A to the subject report; and
- (D) authority be delegated to the Chief Executive Officer to:
 - (1) approve, in consultation with the Lord Mayor, value-in-kind grants for park hire, venue hire (including reduced rates (community and major venues)), banner pole hire and community bus hire;
 - (2) approve, in consultation with the Lord Mayor, Quick Response Grants up to \$1,000 in any one case; and
 - (3) approve any additional funding needed to accommodate cleaning costs for existing community festival contracts (subject to the funding being available in the budget).

HOMELESSNESS BROKERAGE PROGRAM - CONTRACT EXTENSION (S023648)

It is resolved that:

- (A) the current contract with the YWCA of Sydney for provision of the Homelessness Brokerage Program be extended for one year for the period 1 July 2006 - 30 June 2007; and
- (B) authority be delegated to the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate minor changes to the contract to ensure that program outcomes can be met within the funding provided.
