This review of local traffic management is part of the City's commitment of \$52 million to projects to revitalise Redfern, Eveleigh, Darlington and Waterloo. These projects include a major upgrade of Redfern Park and Oval, the Redfern and Regent Streets upgrade.

What Is Local Area Traffic Management (LATM)?

LATM schemes aim to manage traffic on local roads and provide improved safety and amenity for local residents while maintaining reasonable freedom of access for local traffic.

Traffic management measures can include:

- road narrowing
- speed humps
- one way streets
- street closures
- roundabouts
- pedestrian crossings
- cycle lanes.



Project status

The consultants commissioned by the City of Sydney have undertaken a review of the LATM schemes in Redfern based on technical data and input received during community workshops held in July and August.

Additional traffic management works have been identified on a number of streets to improve traffic calming implemented on local streets in Redfern in the 1980s and 90s (primarily road closures, speed humps and one way systems).

The study team would now like to hear your views on the draft LATM scheme.
