The City is undertaking a range of projects to prepare a new set of land use planning controls to guide development in your area.

This new "City Plan" is due for completion by the end of the year.

As a part of this process, I invite you to attend a meeting with the City's consultants to discuss their ideas about building height, character and floor space ratios for Waterloo and Redfern.

At an earlier meeting in April the consultants sought information from the community about desired building character and built form in these areas.

Based on this meeting the consultants have now prepared recommendations and incorporated them into a draft urban design study for the area.

The consultants will present their ideas and will finalise a plan following the meeting, incorporating your comments.

The study will then be incorporated into the City Plan, to guide building controls across the Local Government Area, while tailoring development to suit each area's unique needs.
