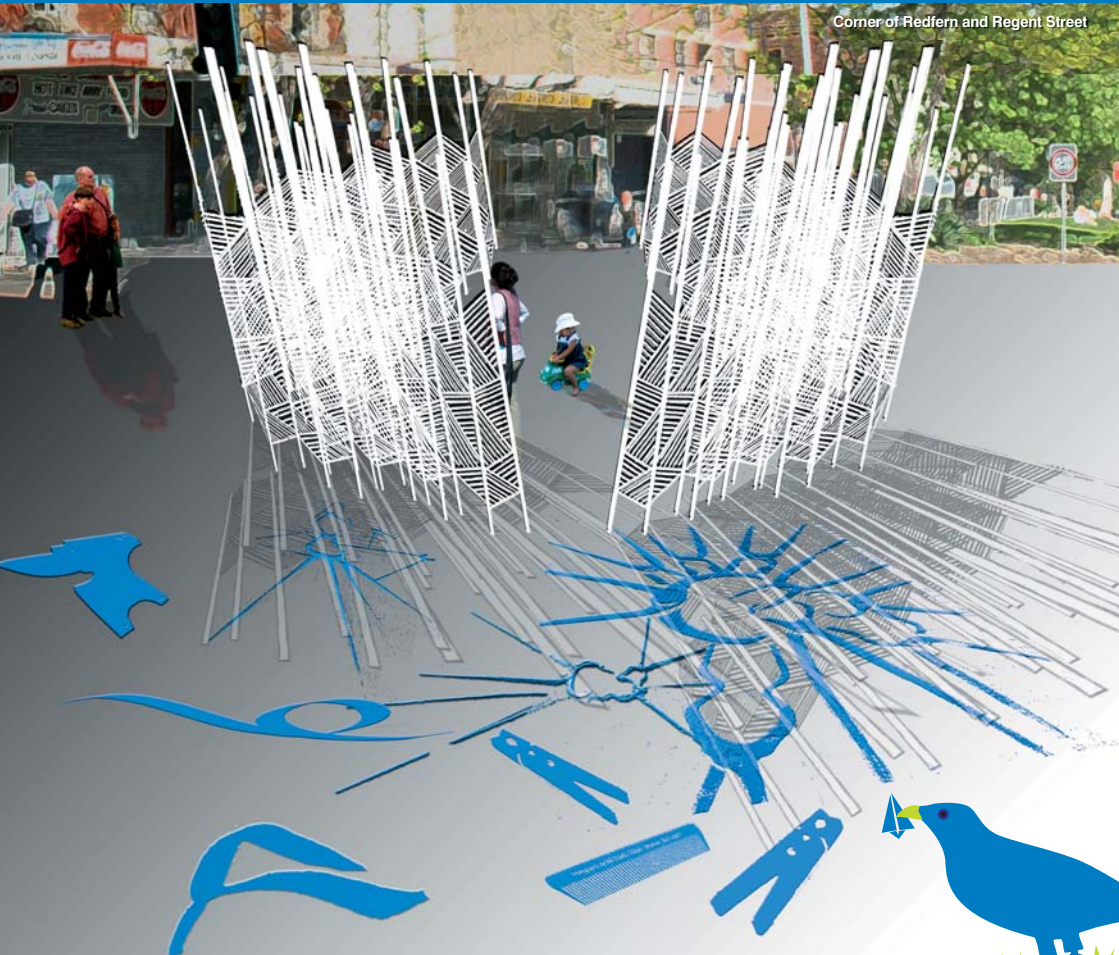


Be part of creating history in Redfern

As part of the \$20 million Redfern and Regent Streets upgrade, the City of Sydney asked for expressions of interest from prominent artists to provide a major work of public art. From the many proposals, an expert committee chose five proposals for public exhibition. In response to community feedback, a public art sculpture by Susan Milne and Greg Stonehouse is to be located at the new park on the corner of Redfern and Regent Streets.

The proposed sculpture is inspired by the bowerbird which borrows blue objects such as pegs and bottle tops to attract females during his courtship dance. Our sculpture will borrow its treasures from the experiences and stories of the Redfern community.

Come to our workshop with your favourite object, we'll photograph it and record the stories and make a glass cast of the objects that best lend themselves to be set in the Redfern Street footpath.
