## ESTABLISHMENT TIMETABLE

<b>Legislative requirement</b>	<b>Action</b>	<b>Date</b>
After complying with procedures a council may, by resolution, adopt a proposal to establish an alcohol free zone. The resolution itself will establish the zone.	Council Meeting	15/12/08
After resolution, a council's usual administrative process would apply in informing interested parties including any applicant, the Anti-discrimination Board, the local Police Commander, affected liquor licensees and other organisations advised of the original proposal.	Mail out to Local Area Commanders, Anti-discrimination Board of NSW and Liquor Licensees with premises adjacent to the AFZ.	16/12/08
A council is required to consult with the police regarding the placement of signs.  As a minimum, signs are to be placed at the out limits of the zone, at the specific trouble spots (as indicated by police) and at other suitable intervals within the zone.	Council Officer to identify sign locations with representatives from City Central and The Rocks Local Area Commands.	16/12/08
A Council must publicly advertise the establishment of an alcohol free zone by notice published in a newspaper circulating in the area that includes the zone.  An alcohol free zone will not operate until 7 days after publication of the notice.	Public notice to be printed in the Sydney Morning Herald	22/12/08
An alcohol free zone will not operate until 7 days after the roads affected are adequately signposted.	Sign installation to be completed.	22/12/08
