Works to the oval and grandstand are nearly finished with restoration of the World War II Cannon and Anzac Memorial complete. Recycled timber is being used in the grandstand and new turf is expected to be laid mid-late 2008 ready for use in early 2009. Mature figs and palms will be planted later this year.
