Proposed designs for the Victoria Park playground upgrade were recently exhibited for community consultation. Concepts being considered include all abilities equipment and a fenced toddler's area. Early upgrade works to Prince Alfred Park will begin later this year, with the main works to begin in early 2009.

The next stage of the Chippendale Improvement Plan is underway.
