



Stage 2 of the project comprises the foreshore works from Rozelle Bay in the west to Blackwattle Bay Park in the east, a length of approximately 1.5km. This is the area subject to this development application. Other areas of the project will be the subject of separate development applications. The proposal compliments the State Government's Access Strategy (Sharing Sydney Harbour Access Strategy) to open up the City's foreshore to the public and to provide a high quality design.

The primary works in Stage 2 include new footpaths, plantings, lighting, maintenance and reconstruction of the sea wall. A proposed new beach area will be located in Bicentennial Park West and will incorporate a rehabilitation area, a small craft beaching area and pontoon. New 'jetties', pontoons and boardwalks for public access to the harbour are proposed along the foreshore and will be subject to Waterways approval.
