City of Sydney's Planning Development and Transport Committee Resolution

18 October 2004

'Mangrove Area requires further investigation

(1A) The proposed mangrove area in Area A (Bicentennial Park West) is not approved at this stage.

The proposed mangrove area shall be subject to further discussion on the merits of this element of the proposal involving relevant experts, the general public and the Waterways Authority.

With regard to the perceived benefits and disadvantages of the mangrove area, at the conclusion of further public consultation, Council will determine whether the proposed mangrove zone will be allowed as part of the development (with or without changes).

Forum Objective

- (1) To provide an opportunity for the general public, to be briefed by relevant experts and the NSW Maritime Authority on the perceived benefits and disadvantages of the proposed mangrove habitat in Area A Bicentennial Park. There will be time for Clarifying Questions.
- (2) On the basis of (1) participants will provide feedback to Council for consideration when determining whether the proposed mangrove zone should be included as part of the Glebe Foreshore Walk.

Principles Underpinning the Forum

- Forum participants are all *world experts* in their view of the world
- There will be no attempt to gain a consensus but rather to ensure that all forum participants have an equal opportunity to express their view
- The purpose of the briefings provided by Council officers and Professional Experts is to provide information to forum participants to assist them in forming their views which will be conveyed to Council.
- All facilitators are highly trained professionals however all have left their professional views outside the room!
- The facilitator's role is to assist participants to record their views and to keep the scheduled time.
- If facilitators express their own views they will be removed from the room!

What Happens Next

- (1) Mangrove Tour to Sydney Olympic Park lead by Luke Saffigna, Senior Ranger, Sydney Olympic Park Authority, at a date to be agreed. Tour participants will be invited to present further feedback to Council following the Tour.
- (2) The People for Places and Spaces (PPS) will analyse all outputs from the forum, the SOPA mangrove tour and prepare a report.
- (3) The PPS forum report will be presented to Council, displayed on Council's website and also be available at the Glebe Neighbourhood Service Centre at Glebe Town Hall.
- (4) On receipt of the PPS Forum report Council will prepare a report and recommendations to be presented to Council's Planning Development and Transport Committee during Council's first meeting cycle in February.
- (5) Council will ensure that this report is available on Council's Website two weeks before the scheduled Planning Development and Transport Committee meeting.
