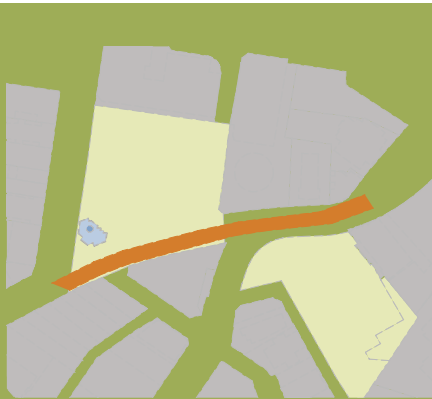


A Vision for the Precinct

Two parks linked by one connecting spine



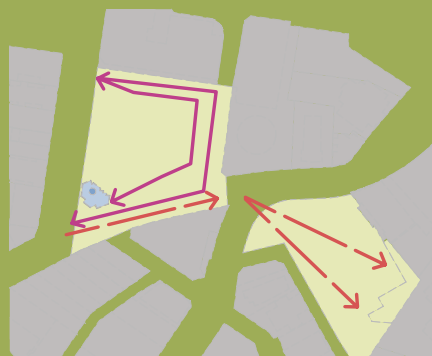
GREEN

FG is framed by gardens. LHR has community gardens, generous lawns & roof gardens stretched towards the view.



VISIBLE ACCESS

Simplifying levels on FG and removing the upper level of the car park will increase visibility and facilitate accessibility.



FOUNTAIN

El Alamein Fountain is reinstated as the entrance to Elizabeth House & Fitzroy Gardens. This reinstatement is reinforced by the pedestrian walkway following the historical line of Elizabeth Bay Rd. This also revives the relationship between Darlinghurst Rd & Elizabeth Bay Rd.



MARKETS

Weekend markets are orientated and focused towards main pedestrian routes.



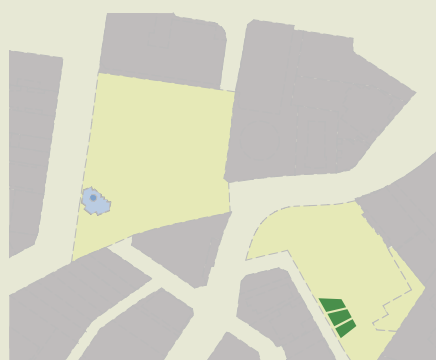
ACTIVATION
