Wondering what to do with your waste?

Moving is a trying experience at the best of times, especially if you have a lot of unwanted furniture or other waste material to dispose of. Did you know that your local council can help?

Marrickville Council and City of Sydney Council both provide **FREE on-call Clean-up services** for most bulk waste. All you have to do is call and book a service, then wait until the day before the arranged collection to put the waste out. Easy isn't it?
