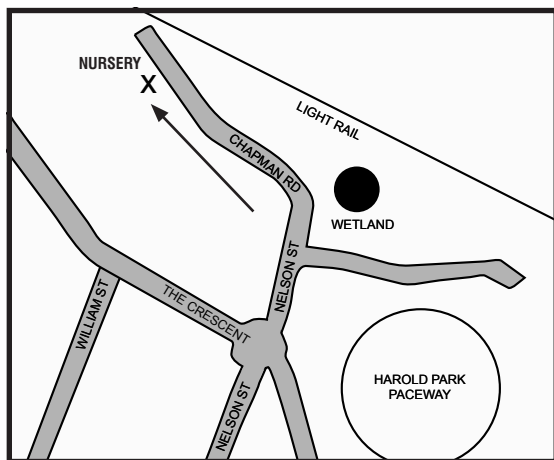

THIS CARD CAN BE PLANTED TO GROW A TREE!

It has been printed using 100% recycled paper containing native Bottlebrush *Callistemon linearis* tree seeds. Height 4m. Red flowers. Prefers full sun. Soil should be moist.

GROWING INSTRUCTIONS Soak card in water until soft. Place in pot filled with potting mix and cover with a thin layer. Water well and keep moist. Seeds should germinate after 1-2 weeks. At about 5cm tall, transplant to individual pots. Once established, trees are ready to plant!
