What is an Access Card?

The Card provides subsidised entry to the City's Aquatic + Fitness Centres for City of Sydney residents who are low income earners. The Card is also available to dependents 16 years and under who live with eligible low income earners.

What are the benefits of the Card?

For those who love the water, the Card allows entry for a swim at any City of Sydney operated aquatic centre for \$2.00. The fee includes access to the steam and sauna at the Ian Thorpe Aquatic Centre.

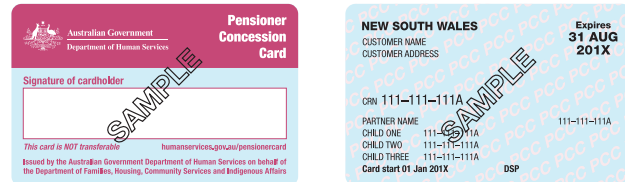
For those looking for a workout, the Card gives you access for just \$5.50 to the fitness centres at:

- Ian Thorpe Aquatic Centre
- Victoria Park Pool
- Cook+Phillip Park Aquatic and Fitness Centre.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible you must:

- Be a resident of the City of Sydney
- Have a valid Commonwealth Health Care Card, a Pensioner Concession Card or Seniors Health Card.



What identification do I need?

When applying for a Card you need to have two forms of identification showing your current residential address. They need to be original documents, not copies.

Applications under financial hardship

City residents experiencing financial hardship may be eligible for an Access Card. To be eligible you, or your household, must be earning (before tax) less than:

- One individual – \$30,925 a year
- Two individuals – \$30,925 to \$51,748 a year
- Families \$51,784 to \$87,630 per year.

If you are applying for a Card because of financial hardship, you must provide:

- The most recent Tax Return for all adults in the household
- The most recent payslip for all working adults in the household
- A Medicare Card (for families only).

If you own assets or property which would reasonably be used to relieve your financial hardship, you may not be eligible for a Card. It is against the law to use false or misleading information in order to obtain a City of Sydney Access Card.

How do I apply?

To apply for a Card, fill out an application form and bring it to any City of Sydney Neighbourhood Service Centre or One Stop Shop.

Your Card will be issued when you present your application form, identification and any other documents are confirmed. The Card is valid for one year from the date of issue.
