

Standard Performance Measures: Environmental Performance - Ratings and Assessment

The City's Environmental Performance Grant – Ratings and Assessment program contains the below set of standard performance measures. This data demonstrates the impact the City's investments are having towards achieving its environmental goals.

The most appropriate measures for supported projects will be included in the funding agreement and the most appropriate representative of the building will need to report on these when acquitting.

Applicants will not be required to report on all performance measures, only those most relevant to their project.
