

Non-resident claim for nomination of an elector by joint/several, corporate or trustee owners, occupiers or ratepaying lessees

Claim for inclusion on the roll of non-resident owners of rateable land or the roll of occupiers and ratepaying lessees for the City of Sydney.

The nominee must be enrolled on the NSW or Federal electoral rolls with an enrolled address outside of the City of Sydney local government area.

The person making this claim must represent:

- a corporation, trust or lessee of Crown land that owns, occupies or pays rates on a City of Sydney rateable property OR
- a group of individuals and/or corporations and/or trusts and/or Crown land lessees that owns, occupies or pays rates on a City of Sydney rateable property

where

- an owner pays rates on the rateable property
- an occupier has the right to occupy the rateable property for at least 3 years from the application date
- a rate-paying lessee has a documented liability to contribute to any rates due on the rateable property for at least 3 years from the application date.

If you own, occupy or are a ratepaying lessee by yourself as an individual use 'Non-resident claim for individual owner, occupier or ratepaying lessee'.

Note: A person cannot vote more than once in any City of Sydney local government election.
