City of Sydney's newest sport stadium is located in the heart of Perry Park, Alexandria.

The centre has four multipurpose courts, catering for sports such as basketball, futsal, netball, badminton and volleyball plus a range of other recreational activities.

There is a kiosk and an outdoor terrace located on site. Visitors can grab a snack and coffee and enjoy some shade or warm sunshine in the park.

Car

Parking is limited on the surrounding streets. Accessible parking is available on site.



Bus

Buses stop in front of the centre or nearby. Bus services include:

- 305 Stamford Hotel to Central Railway
- 308 Marrickville Metro to City (via Redfern)
- 348 Wolli Creek to Bondi Junction
- 370 Leichhardt to Coogee
- M20 Botany to Gore Hill
- 309 Port Botany Depart to Central Railway Square
- 310 Eastgardens to Central Railway Square (via Botany Road)



Train

11 minute walk from Green Square Railway Station. Regular train services include:

- T2 Airport line
- Inner West and South Line



Bicycle

Cycleway runs along Bourke Road from Gardeners Road linking to Prince Alfred Park in Surry Hills. There are on-site bicycle parking facilities.



Walking

We are an 11 minute walk from Green Square Station, and between two to 11 minutes from bus routes. There are regular bus services available to Green Square Station, which is a short walk to Perry Park.
