

Woolloomooloo Children's Program Vacation Care – Spring 2022

Dates: Monday 26 September to Friday 7 October

Daily Cost: Free. Free for eligible non-fee paying and all Plunkett St Public School students - Excursion/incursion costs only. Excursion/incursion costs apply for all cancellations.

All other families discounted fee of \$9.15 plus additional excursion/incursion costs. Daily fee and excursion/incursion costs apply for all cancellations.

Some excursions and activities will incur a cost as outlined in the table below. Excursion/incursion costs apply for all cancellations/absences.

Opening hours: 10am to 6pm. Penalties apply for late collection of children.

Bookings

Bookings close on 16 September 2022. Booking forms attached to this program must be completed and submitted for your booking to be processed. You need to notify us if your child will be absent.

Payment

Fees must be paid prior to the start of vacation care. Please speak to staff to arrange payment.

What to bring and wear

Pack for the following for your child each day:

- A hat that offers good sun protection
- A healthy lunch, snacks and drinks
- Safety gear (such as bike helmets)
- Sunscreen

Do not pack any valuables. We are unable to take responsibility for or secure valuables, including toys and electronic games or money.

Children should wear appropriate clothes to the centre each day. No singlets or singlet dresses are allowed. Children must wear closed in shoes on excursions. If your child is dressed inappropriately for the day's activity or is not dressed to meet our sun smart policy, you may be requested to collect your child from the centre or to provide appropriate clothes.

Signing in and out

All children must be signed in and out by a parent or guardian and visual contact must be made with a member of staff.

Absences and sick children

If you have booked but cannot attend, please notify us as soon as possible. Sick children are not permitted to attend the centre as they may spread infection. If you need us to administer medication to your child, you must complete a form – please ask one of our team members.

Swimming excursions

Children should be comfortable in the water and be able to swim and dress themselves unassisted. They should be 6 years of age or older. Five-year olds and non-swimmers will have shallow water options.
