Do I need to include written references in my application?	<p>You don't need to provide written references with the application, but links to any supporting documentation are highly encouraged. This could include photo documentation (including your own website), reviews and audience feedback, descriptions/write ups on a venue or festivals website. Do the creatives involved need to be artists who live or work within the City of Sydney?	<p>The artists or performers involved don't necessarily need to live within the City of Sydney, but the content does need to be relevant to the area and our local communities.</p>	06/01/2024
Do the sort of stories I tell fit in with what is being asked for?	<p>The City of Sydney's Storytellers is a program to share stories from people in our community, showcasing the rich diversity to audiences within our libraries and community spaces. While you don't need to live within the City of Sydney, the stories should have some relevance to our area and local communities. Stories can be told creatively through song, dance, discussion, theatre or spoken word and may be a single piece or part of a collection. As part of the EOI you will need to explain how your stories are relevant to the local area and how you intend to share them with local communities.</p>	09/01/2024
