
Design Update

In 2022 we consulted with the community and are continuing to work with Transport for NSW to find safe and effective ways to make our streets better for people.


We are planning a series of traffic calming and landscaping treatments on Primrose Avenue, Confectioners Way, and Spring Street to make the area a better, safer place to walk and ride while reducing the amount and speed of traffic. These combined elements are referred to as a quiet way. The key updates and current design can be seen below.




Design Update

The key changes are as follows:

- Changes to traffic priority and access to reduce through traffic and improve safety for people walking. We have worked with local businesses to improve the vehicle movements on Primrose Avenue;
- more green space for the community with a park at the intersection of Gardeners Road and Primrose Avenue;
- reorganised parking and new tree locations to improve the amenity of the street and contributing to the City's greening and canopy targets, and increasing shade; and
- new pedestrian crossings and other traffic calming measures including a raised intersection at the corner of Crew Place and Primrose to provide a continuous footpath.
