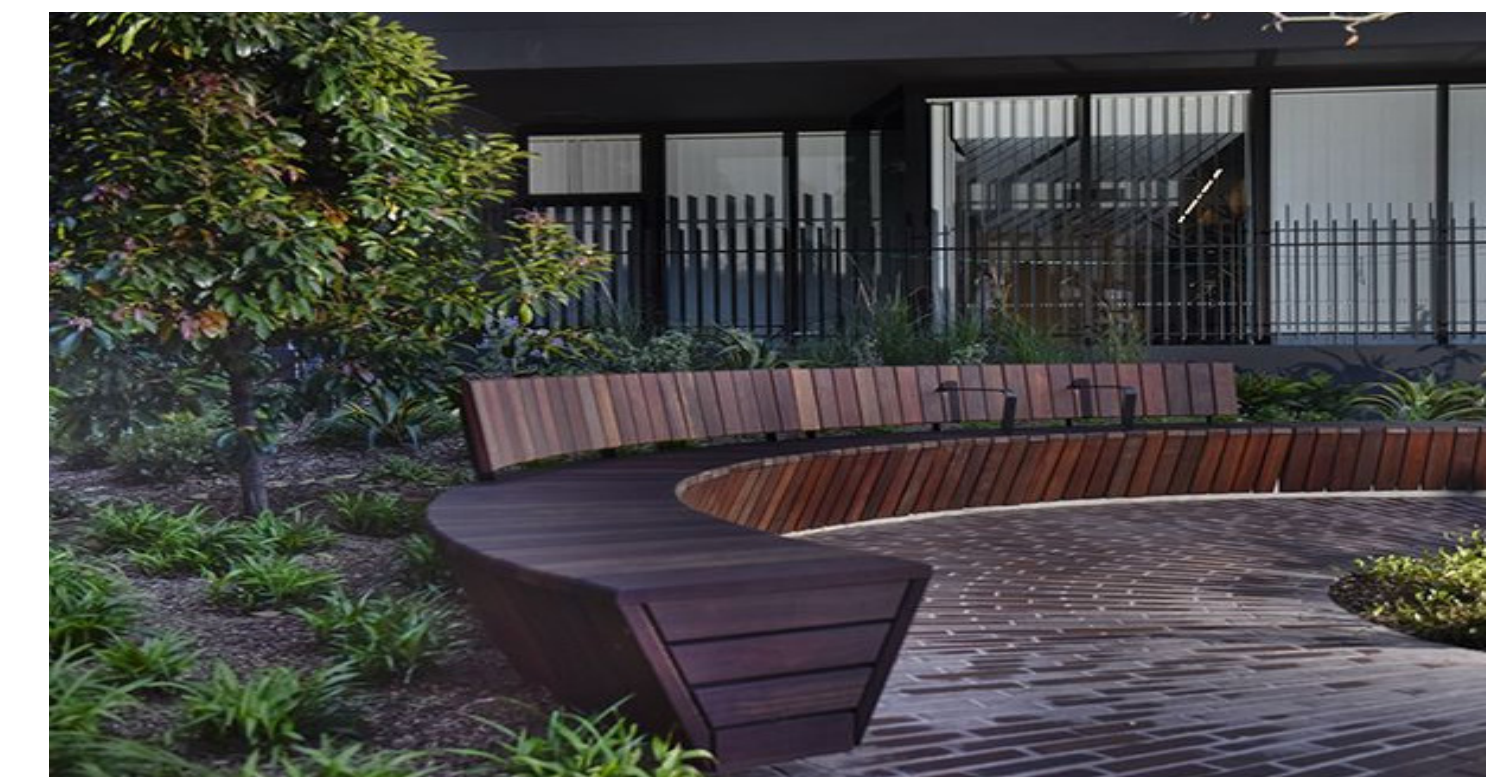








- 05** New timber deck
- 06** New entry point
- 07** New low fence
- 08** Retain existing laneway access to Broughton Lane
