

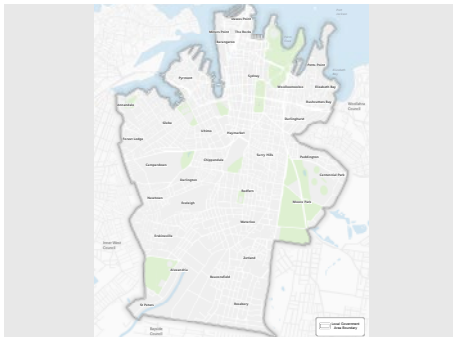
# Open all year grants in the grants and sponsorship program



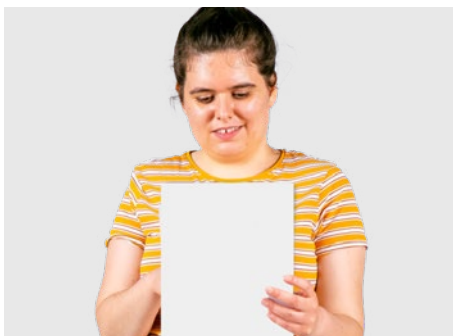
# About this information



City of Sydney made this information.



**City of Sydney** is the part of the government that looks after the city area of Sydney.



This information is about our **grants and sponsorship program**.



Our **grants and sponsorship program** gives money for you to work on a project.

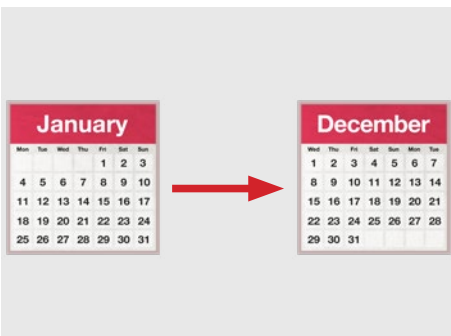
We will say **grants** for short.



We have many different grants.



This information is about 5 of the grants.



These grants are called **open all year grants**.



**Open all year grants** are grants you can apply for at any time in the year.

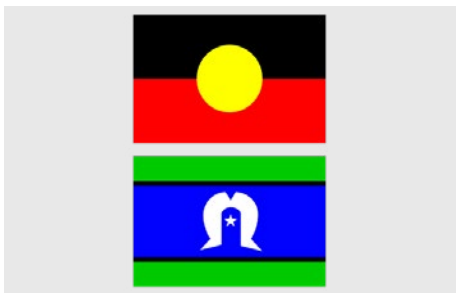


You need to work or live in the City of Sydney area to apply.



If you do not work or live in City of Sydney you must show how the project will be good for City of Sydney.

# 1. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander collaboration fund



This grant is called the **Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander collaboration fund**.



This is for projects for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in Sydney.



We are looking for projects that

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are in charge of
- Do good things for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- Support local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander organisations to do more things.



We may be able to give you money for up to 3 years.



**\$50 thousand**

You can get up to \$50 thousand for a project.

**CITY OF SYDNEY** 



You can apply to use City of Sydney **venues** for your project.

**Venues** are places the City of Sydney owns.



You can use **value in kind** to use the City of Sydney venues.

**Value in kind** means the City of Sydney pays for it.



You can also use value in kind for our street banners.



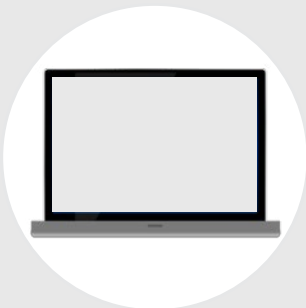
**\$5 thousand**

You can apply for \$5 thousand for **capital expenditure**.

**Capital expenditure** is when you get money for things you need in the project like



- Tools that might be cameras

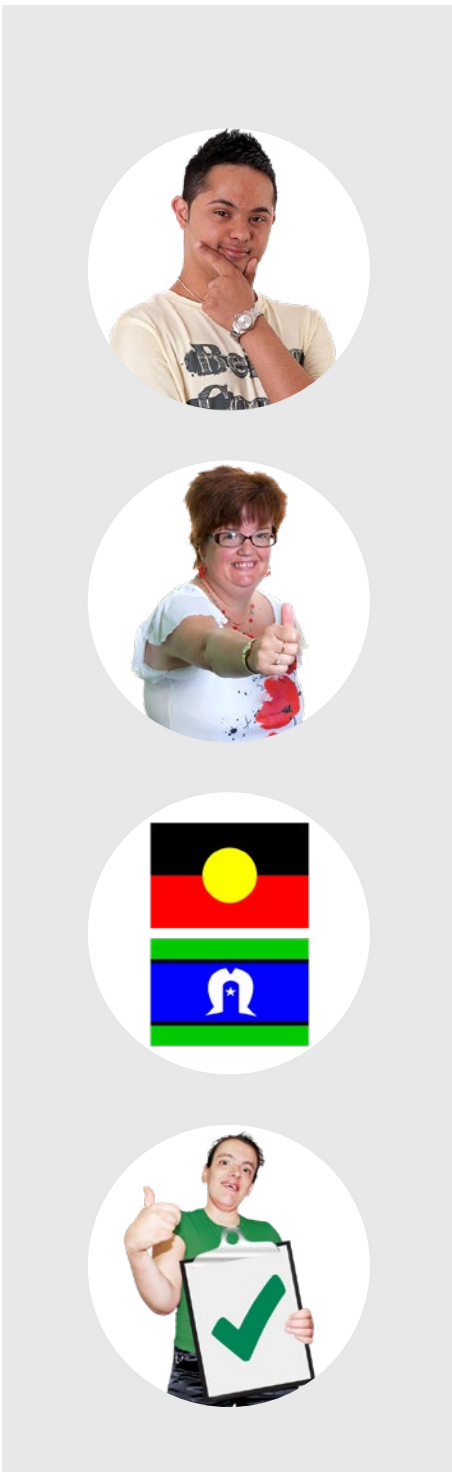


- Laptops.



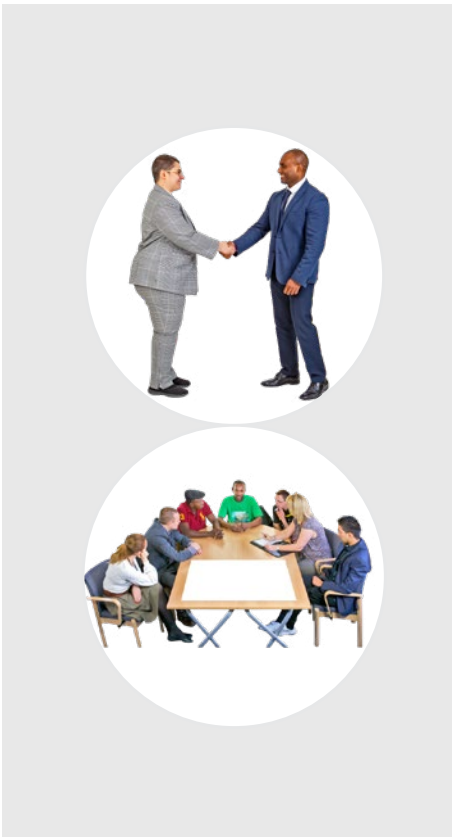
You can put what **insurance** will cost when you apply.

**Insurance** is money you can get if something goes wrong.



When we decide if you get the project we will look at things like

- Why the project is needed
- If you have the skills to do the project
- How the project will be good for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- If you have done these kind of projects before.



You can apply if you are

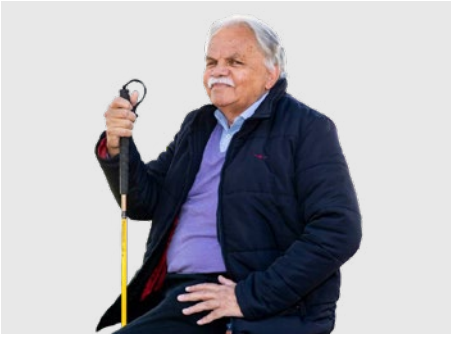
- On your own with support from a **legal entity**
- Part of a legal entity.



A **legal entity** is a type of organisation.



You can contact the City of Sydney to learn more about the types of legal entities that can apply.



If you are an organisation your bosses must be mostly Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people.



You will need to give proof that you are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.

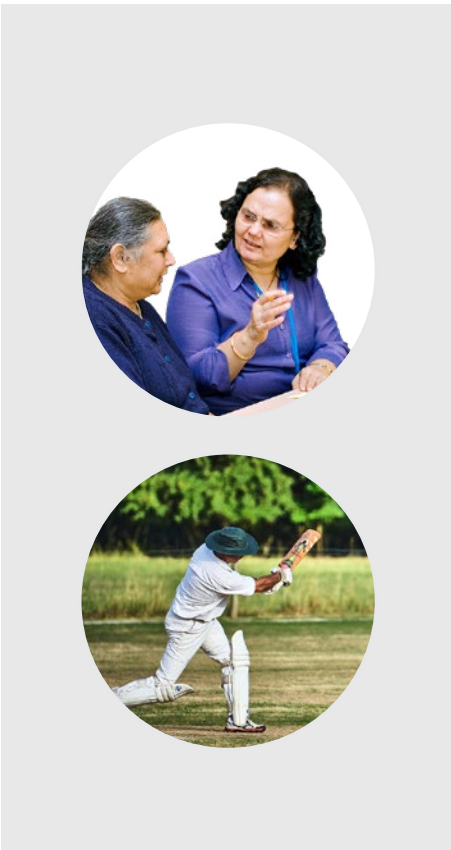
## 2. Quick response grant



This grant is called the **quick response grant**.

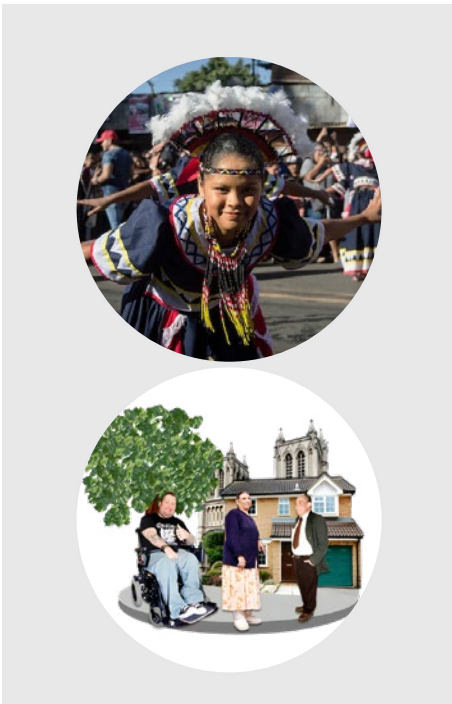


It is for small projects that support people to make their local community better.



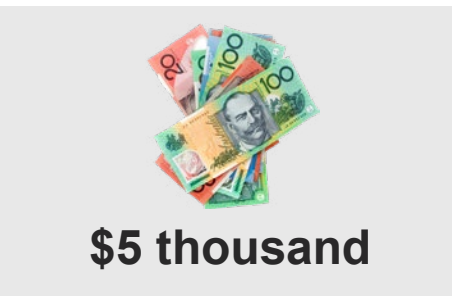
We are looking for projects that

- Support people in need in the City of Sydney
- Support people or teams to play for Sydney in sport.

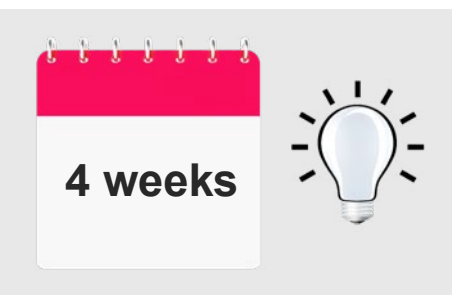


We are looking for projects that do things like

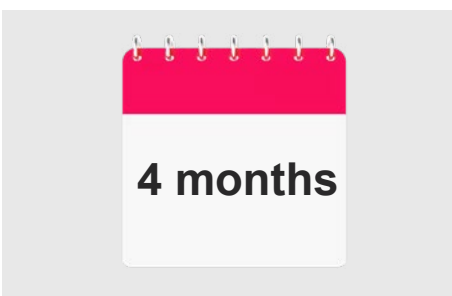
- Make communities feel stronger
- Give support for people in the community who need it straight away.



You can get up to \$5 thousand for the project.



You have to tell us your project idea at least 4 weeks before you want your project to start.



You have to do the project in 4 months.

You can get value in kind for venue hire if you are an organisation.



**\$5 thousand**

You can get up to \$5 thousand for capital expenditure.



You can put what insurance will cost when you apply.

When we decide if you get the money we will look at things like



- Why the project is needed now



- How you will work with groups in the community



- The skills you have to do the project.

You can apply for up to \$5 thousand if you are



- On your own



- Doing the project with someone else



- Part of a legal entity



- Doing the project with a legal entity.



You can contact the City of Sydney to learn more about the types of legal entities that can apply.

### 3. Affordable and diverse housing fund



This grant is called the **affordable and diverse housing fund**.



It is for projects that help build more places that are cheaper for people to live.



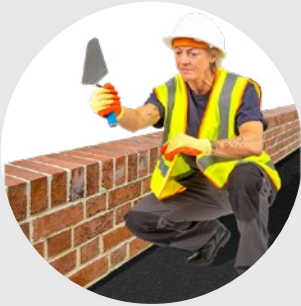
We are looking for projects that do things like

- Get housing organisations in Sydney to join the project
- Do good things for people in Sydney who need cheap places to live
- Get money from other places to help with the cost of the project.

You can use the money to



- Buy land



- Build places that will be cheap for people to live in.



**\$3 million**

You can get up to \$3 million for the project.

When we decide if you get the money we will look at things like



- How much new housing you will make



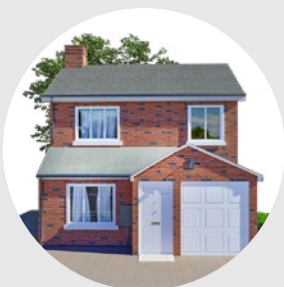
- Where the new housing will be



- How much money it will cost



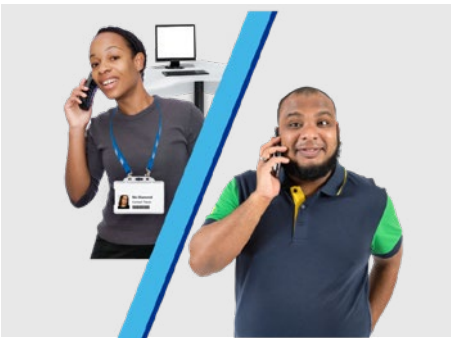
- If you have enough money to finish it



- If you have made buildings for housing before.



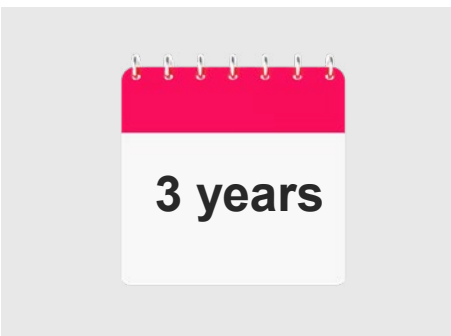
You can apply if you are a part of a legal entity.



You can contact the City of Sydney to learn more about the the types of legal entities that can apply.



You can **not** apply for this grant if you are on your own.



You must start building in 3 years after we give you the money.



The housing you make should be used by people who do not have a lot of money.



You must follow the government rules when you run the housing.



You might need to give us the money back if you do not finish your project.

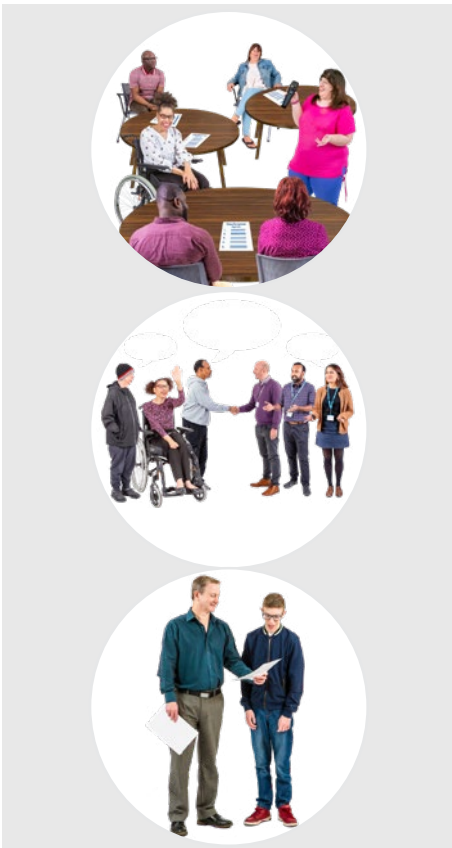
## 4. Venue hire support grant



This grant is called the **venue hire support grant**.



It is to help groups use our venues.



We are looking for projects that

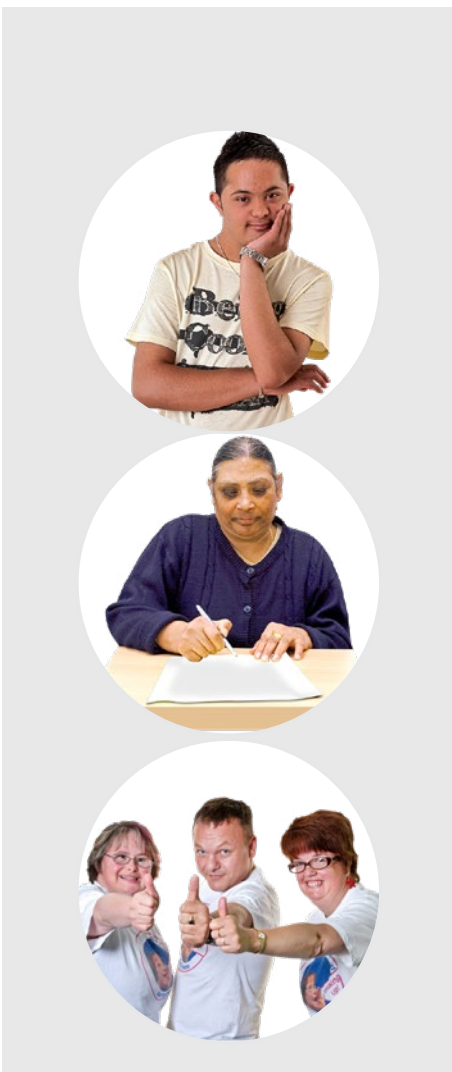
- Have events that let people be a part of things
- Help make services better for people who live in the City of Sydney
- Share information to support our services to do more things.



We can give support to use our venues for less money.



We can give you this support for up to 3 years.



When we decide if you get the money we will look at things like

- Why the project is needed
- If you have the skills to do the project
- How it will be good for the local community.



You can apply as a local community group without a legal entity.



You can also apply if you are part of a legal entity.



You can contact the City of Sydney to learn more about the types of legal entities that can apply.

## 5. Street banner sponsorship

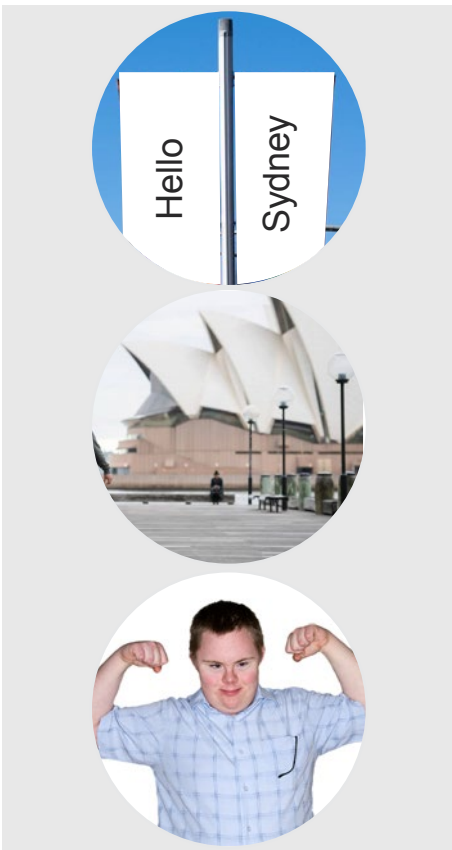


This grant is called **street banner sponsorship**.



It is for projects who want to use our **banner poles** for cheaper money.

**Banner poles** are poles you can put banners on.



We are looking for projects that

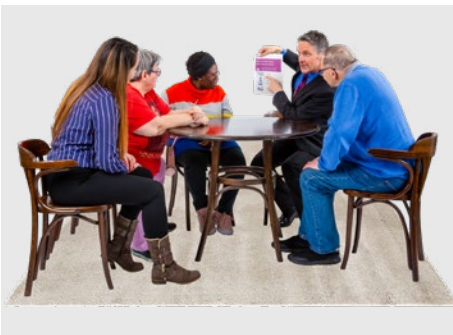
- Let more people know about big issues and events
- Help make Sydney look like a nice place
- Help communities be strong.



You can ask for value in kind for street banner poles.



But you will need to get the banners and pay for them.



You can apply if you are part of a legal entity.



You can contact the City of Sydney to learn more about the types of legal entities that can apply.

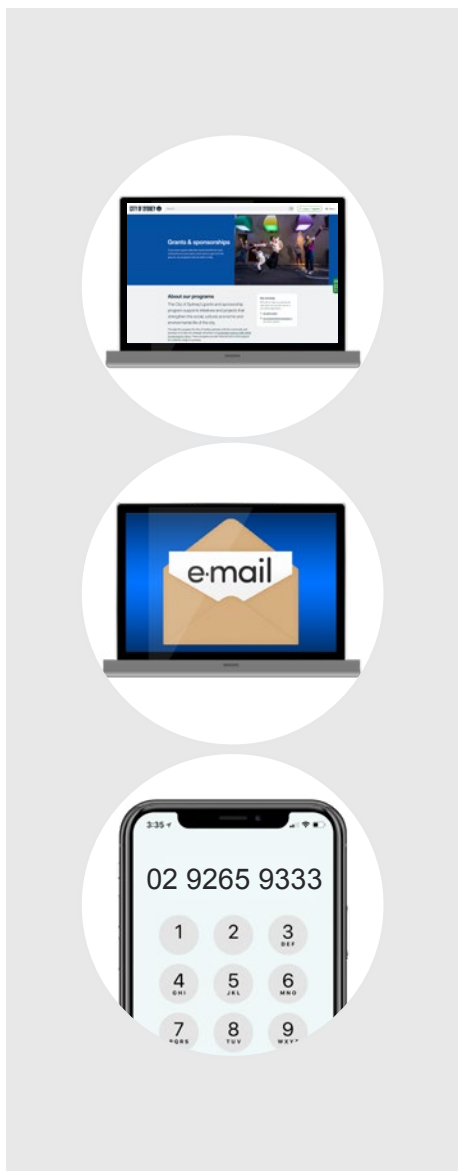


We must say yes to the banners before you make them.



We can decide how many banners you get and where they go.
