

City of Sydney is the part of the government that looks after the city area of Sydney.



This information is about our **grants and sponsorship program**.



Our **grants and sponsorship program** gives money for you to work on a project.

We will say **grants** for short.




We have 14 different grants.

This information is about 5 of the grants.



These grants are called **value in kind** grants.

Value in kind is when we let you use City of Sydney venues and banner poles for free.



You must work or live in the City of Sydney area to apply.



If you do not work or live in the City of Sydney area you can still apply.

You must show us how the project will be good for the City of Sydney.


1. Venue hire support grants and sponsorship



This grant is called the **venue hire support grants and sponsorship**.




It is to help groups use our venues.



We are looking for projects that

- Have more events that let people be a part of things
- Have more services for people who live in the City of Sydney.




We are looking for projects that

- Have more **skills** for **organisations** to share information with people

An **organisation** is a group of people who work together for the same reason

Skills are things you are good at.



You can apply at any time in the year.



We can give support to use our venues for less money.

When we decide if you get the money we will look at things like



- Why the project is needed



- If you have the skills to do the project



- How it will be good for the **community**

Community means the place where you and others live



- If there are people from different **cultures** in your project

Culture means the way you do things because of where you or your family are from



- If there are people with disability in your project.

You can apply if you are a

- **Not for profit** organisation

Not for profit means your organisation spends the money it makes on things that make the organisation better

- On your own with an **auspice**

An **auspice** is an organisation that supports your grant application

- Community group

- **Event organisation** doing a project for a not for profit organisation

An **event organisation** puts on events in the community.



We will not pay for money for staff at the venues.

2. Street banner sponsorship




This grant is called **street banner sponsorship**.



It is for projects who want to use our **banner poles** for cheaper money.

Banner poles are poles you can put banners on.



We are looking for projects that

- Let more people know about big issues and events
- Help make Sydney look like a nice place
- Help communities be strong.



You can apply at any time in the year.



You can only ask for value in kind for street banner poles.

We will not pay for the banners.



You have to pay for and bring the banners yourself.



You can only apply if you are a not for profit organisation.



We must say yes to the banners before you make them.



We decide how many banners you get and where they go.

3. Accommodation grant




This grant is called the **accommodation grant**.




It lets you **rent** spaces for up to 5 years.

Rent is when you pay money to work somewhere.



We can give you cheaper rent.



Or you may not have to pay any rent.

- Help people feel less alone



- Have more services for the area



- Help make more money for small organisations and artists




- Let people be a part of creative things




- Share information with people



- Help fix problems in the community.

A **bond** is when you give us money before you start in case something goes wrong.

When we decide if you get the place we will look at things like



- Why the project is needed



- If your organisation has the skills to do the project



- How your organisation will be good for the community



- If there are people from different cultures in your project



- If there are people with disability in your project.

You can apply if you are a



- Not for profit organisation




- **For profit** organisation.

For profit means your organisation makes money to spend on yourselves.

4. Creative live work spaces grant




This is called the **creative live work spaces grant**.



It lets artists rent City of Sydney places to live and work in.



We can support you by giving you cheaper rent.




We are looking for projects that help artists to

- If the place is good for your art.




- How the place will help you get better at your art

- Writing.




You have to be 18 years old to apply.

5. Short term empty properties grant




This is called the **short term empty properties grant**.




This is for organisations who want to use our empty places for short times.

It can be from 1 month to 1 year.




We can support you by giving you the place for less money.




We are looking for organisations that




When we decide if you get the place we will look at things like

You must show us how your organisation will help the City of Sydney.



You can apply if you are a

- Not for profit organisation

- For profit organisation

- **Sole trader**

Sole trader means you own your own business

- Community group with an auspice.


