






The five least used entrances






Hourly sample count of people entering the Park by entrance on Friday 24th March 2006 from 8pm to 11pm










Hourly sample count of people entering the Park by entrance on Friday 24th March 2006 from 8pm to 10pm... cont'd


Total sample count of people entering the Park by entrance on Wednesday 22nd March 2006 from 7.30am to 6.30pm






People entering the Park by entrance in blocks of time








Total sample count of people entering the Park by gender




People entering the Park by gender, hour by hour








The location of wheelchairs, baby strollers, cyclists and rollerbladers entering Hyde Park
