Dogs bring great joy and companionship to many of our residents. But for the health and welfare of your pet and your community, please be a responsible dog owner.

Always pick up after your dog in a public space. Not doing this is unhealthy and unsafe. It's also illegal.

Dog waste can spread infectious diseases and parasites to other animals and humans, through direct contact or when it rains and the waste is washed into our waterways.

Dog waste on paths and in parks also spoils your neighbourhood and is very unpleasant for your neighbours. People can also hurt themselves if they slip and fall.

City Rangers can issue on-the-spot fines of up to **\$300** for not picking up your dog's waste.

You will find free waste bags in most parks, but it's always best to bring some bags with you.
